Dear Parent/Carer

The following letter sets out the arrangements in school for this Year's A Level and GCSE results days. These will take place on the same dates as previously publicised:

- **Thursday 13th August – A Level Results Day**
- **Thursday 20th August – GCSE Results Day**

However, in light of the circumstances around Covid-19 we will be managing results day differently to previous years. It is important to note that the health and safety of staff, students and visitors is of paramount importance in putting in place these arrangements.

With this in mind we are only asking for students **or** their representative to come on to the school site at their allotted time.

Booking a time to collect results

Parents will use the online booking system (see details below) to book in for one of a range of fifteen minute slots. Each slot will accommodate fifteen individuals (students or their representative) to come on to site to collect their results. This will allow us to control the number of people on site and maintain social distancing.

The booking system will be **open from Monday 13th July 2020 at 8.00am and close Monday 27th July 2020 at 4.00pm** to make your appointment. If you have any problems booking a slot please contact the school 01623 464220. Please note that while the booking will generate a specific time within the fifteen minute slot i.e. 9.05, 11.14 this can be disregarded. Students or their representatives should aim to arrive on site for the start of the 15 minute slot they selected.

Practical Arrangements

- On arrival to school please use the main pedestrian gate
- Senior members of staff will be on hand to direct students or their representatives
- You will be asked to queue in a designated area outside the main gate, you will only need to wait for a short period of time.
- Individuals will be invited into Room 5 via an external door where they will be able to collect their result's envelopes.
- They will be directed out a separate exit and will be able to leave the site via the main pedestrian gate.

Support for Year 13 students on A Level Results Day:

- There will be provision in IT2 for students to access computers if they need to log in to UCAS or contact their chosen university. Mr Brennan and Miss Hadley will be available for support.

Support for Year 11 students hoping to join the Sixth Form on GCSE Results Day:

- There will be provision to speak to one of three members of staff about moving into Sixth Form whether this relates to a new enquiry about joining, a change to the subjects opted for, or a concern about having missed the entry requirements.

For obvious reasons we would like to avoid groups gathering on the school site and ask that once results have been collected and any discussions with staff relating to University Places (Year 13) or Sixth Form places (Year 11) have been completed, individuals leave the site promptly being mindful of social distancing rules.

If students or their representatives do not turn up at their allocated time we will post results to the address we have on the school system. If students would like someone to collect their results on their behalf please contact Mrs Ireson, Exams Officer email sireson@garibaldschool.co.uk

Due to GDPR we will not be able to give results to your representative without prior permission.

Year 11 students or their representative will be able to collect their leavers' hoodies at the same time as picking up result envelopes.

While these arrangements are some way from a normal results day, we do hope you can appreciate the changes that have had to be made. We look forward to seeing students receive their results and to congratulate them on their successes.
